### **VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM ACT**

- Became law June 1, 2009
- Began accepting applications January 1, 2010
- Fundamental shift in concept of cleanup
- 109 Applications to Date
- 12-8-107(g)(2) GW corrective action not required if no receptors
- Bright Line vs. Area Averaging
- Ask the experts at EPA?

- Lies, Damn Lies, and Statistics
- Exposure Domain
- Variogram analysis
- Samples utilized
- Acute exposure / not-to-exceed criteria
- Hot spots
- Leaching



# **COLLABORATION**

- Bring on the Expert
- Training Seminars
- Use of default non-residential standard
- Additional pre and post-excavation sampling to address question marks



# DATA PRESENTATION

- Raw sample data with locations
- Variogram and associated data
- Kriging Estimation output
- Kriging Variance output
- VSP standard formatted report
- Figure of kriged blocks with data point overlay (color-coded)
- Sensitivity analysis



# **GENERAL TAKEAWAYS**

- Valid CSM and Exposure Domain
- Is it worth the effort?
  - Small exceedance areas
  - residential scenarios
  - Subsurface impacts
- Is site characterized /data set representative of ED
- Covenant required to enforce ED and other assumptions
- Still need to evaluate potential leaching
- Early and regular communication
- Guidance on EPD website by EOY
